NATIONAL REGISTRATION CENTER – A NEW MODEL FOR BUSINESS REGISTRATION



Business registration reform with the focus:

- ✓ Reducing the barriers for business incorporation, and improving the business climate in Albania;
- ✓ Introducing the one stop shop model;
- √ Improving Albania's fiscal position;
- √ Fighting corruption.

BUSINESS REGISTRATION BEFORE THE CREATION OF THE NRC



- √ Registering a business in Albania demanded:
 - √ A large number of judicial and administrative barriers;
 - ✓ Increases the costs of registration;
 - √ The process was too long (more than 45 days) and costly;
 - √ Create premises for market distortion;
 - √ Creation of opportunities for corruption.





Purpose of the law:

- ✓ Improving and simplifying the procedures for business incorporation.
- ✓ Creates and manage the commercial register.
- ✓ Electronic registration system and data storage;
- ✓ Harmonization of registration procedures with European Union directives.

Improvements:

- √ Self declaration;
- ✓ Minimize the time and cost of registration.
- ✓ Simultaneous registration to the tax authorities, social and health care insurance, labor inspectorate (NUIS);
- ✓ Prompted and updated information.

Functions of NRC



- ✓ Maintains the commercial register;
- ✓ Ensure business incorporation and other registrations during the live circle of the businesses;
- ✓ Registration for tax purposes, health and social insurance and labor inspectorate;
- ✓ Deliver the NUIS (unique number of identification);
- ✓ Issues certificates, registration extracts and validated copies of documents part of the register;
- ✓ Ensures free access to the public (<u>www.qkr.gov.al</u>); Prompted and updated information
- ✓ Informs and advices the parties concerned on the registration procedures.

Commercial register



- ✓ Presents a full updated picture of the business developmnets;
- ✓ A unique database of businesses that according to the Albanian legislation can develop an economic activity.
- ✓ Acts as an instrument for economic information about the business developments;
- ✓ Provides knowlede and publicity for the businesses activities;
- ✓ Is electronic and open to the public, the information is updated every 2 hours;

The National Registration Centre



- √ The centre has 33 desks in the territory.
- √ The NRC provides a unified service for the applications.
- ✓ NRC operates under an integrated electronic data system which links the regional service desks with the NRC's headquarters in Tirana.



Who can register:

- Natural persons;
- Commercial entities, (limited liability, simple companies, join stock companies);
- Savings and credit Associations/ unions;
- Mutual cooperation companies;
- Branches or representative offices of foreign company;
- Agricultural cooperatives.
- Etc.

Main Services:

- ✓ Business incorporation;
- ✓ Other registrations (changes in the address, business name, board of directors, filling the annual balance sheet, etc.;
- √ Reserve or transfer a name;
- ✓ Issuing the NUIS and the registration certificate);
- ✓ Deregistration;
- ✓ Issue of extracts for any data of commercial registry;
- ✓ Provide statistical data processing.

Business incorporation



Procedures

- ✓ The registration is carried our electronically using the on-line procedure (on-line application https://www.e-albania.al/) or physically at every NRC desks on national bases;
- ✓ Business incorporation procedure consists in two phases: Phase one -Application for registration; Phase two – Evaluation and decisionmaking.

Time and cost

- √ The cost for application is 100 ALL (0.7 euro);
- ✓ For the online applications the cost is zero;
- √ The registration takes only 24 h;
- √ The deregistration process takes from 30-90 days;
- ✓ After the deadline (24h) the silent approval is in place.

...the process



Application

- ✓ The applicant assisted by the desk clerk submits hard copies of supporting documents, identification documents,..etc.;
- ✓ Originals documents are not necessary, notary documents are not needed;
- ✓ At the end he receives an electronic version of application form with a case number (the number of the application;

Evaluation and decision making

- ✓ The examiner (back office) vverifies whether all mandatory fields of the application form are filled in, and the supporting documents;
- ✓ Checks whether the documents, supporting the data registered, are in the form required;
- ✓ Do not check the content /accuracy of the act to be register.

New developments



On-line registration.

- ✓ From December 2014 we are providing the online registration (https://www.e-albania.al/);
 - ✓ Reduce the registration time from 8 h to 4 h.
 - ✓ No additional costs.
 - ✓ Reduce the visits to the front desks from 2 to 0.
 - ✓ All the information is available electronically;
 - √ We are using the electronic signature;



Web page User friendly

- ✓ Increase the searching engine from 40 to 5.2 seconds, our target is to provide a real time data.
- ✓ A new face for data display;
- ✓ A proactive webpage; NRC has reached a record number of visitors compared to the same period last year, with an increase of 116% compared with 2013.

Bulletin of business registration

✓ From December 2013, in the framework of improvement and facilitation of business registration, the NRC started to publish electronically the <u>Bulletin of Business Registration</u>, which generates all the data registered in Commercial Registry in the last 24h.



Check your application status

✓ You can check online the registration status (approved, suspended and rejected) and the reasons.

Electronic signature

✓ Since 22 April 2014, the National Registration Centre ensures the provision of electronically signed documents. We are the first public institution who delivers such service.

Research for a name

✓ Any individual can have on-line access to the portal and research for a name available before making the registration to the NRC.
