Register of beneficial owners (1)

- Functional as of 1 January 2018
- Independent register, not part of public or commercial register
- Maintained by Register Courts
- Non-public

Register of beneficial owners (2)

- Information on beneficial owners of
 - 1. Registered corporate and other legal entities and
 - 2. Trusts and similar arrangements

Access to the BO register (1)

- Two types of access:
 - 1. For anyone (with legitimate interest)
 - 2. For competent authorities (relevant state agencies, obliged entities according to the AML Act etc.)

Access to the BO register (2)

- Access to anyone:
 - Legitimate interest in connection with prevention from specific offences need to be demonstrated
 - Only part of the information will be provided

Access to the BO register (3)

- Access to competent authorities:
 - Relevant state agencies, obliged entities according to the AML Act etc.
 - Direct access via internet application (interface)
 - Pre-registration of users needed
 - Information will be displayed immediately

Content of the BO register (1)

- The record in the BO register shall contain the information specifying
 - who the beneficial owner is and
 - what the beneficial ownership is based on

Content of the BO register (2)

Sec. 118f of the Act No. 304/2013 Coll.:

- a) name and address of the place of stay, and also the place of residence if it differs from the place of stay,
- b) date of birth and the birth number if assigned,
- c) nationality,
- d) information on
 - 1. a share in the voting rights, if the position of beneficial owner is based upon his direct business share in the legal person,
 - 2. a share in profits, if the beneficial owner is a beneficiary,
 - 3. any other facts if the position of beneficial owner is based otherwise.

Registration process (2)

- Registered entities just report the information on their BO
- Submission (application)
 - Via page form
 - Can be filled in solely electronically
 - Can be filed either electronically or in paper
 - Documents from which follows who the beneficial owner is

Registration process (2)

- Vetting process
 - Register Court solely confirms the existence of designated natural person (beneficial owner)
 - No other formal or material control of provided data (no investigation whether the natural person designated as the BO is in fact the BO)

Quality of registered data

- Depends on activity of registered entities
- Change only based on the submission of the registered entity
- No fines or other sanctions (for omission to file/wrong filing the register)

Perspective

- Experience with the usage of the BO register is a precondition for its possible improvement
- More will be known in 2018 and 2019
- Technical and legislative changes (access, sanctions etc.) of the register will be considered eventually
