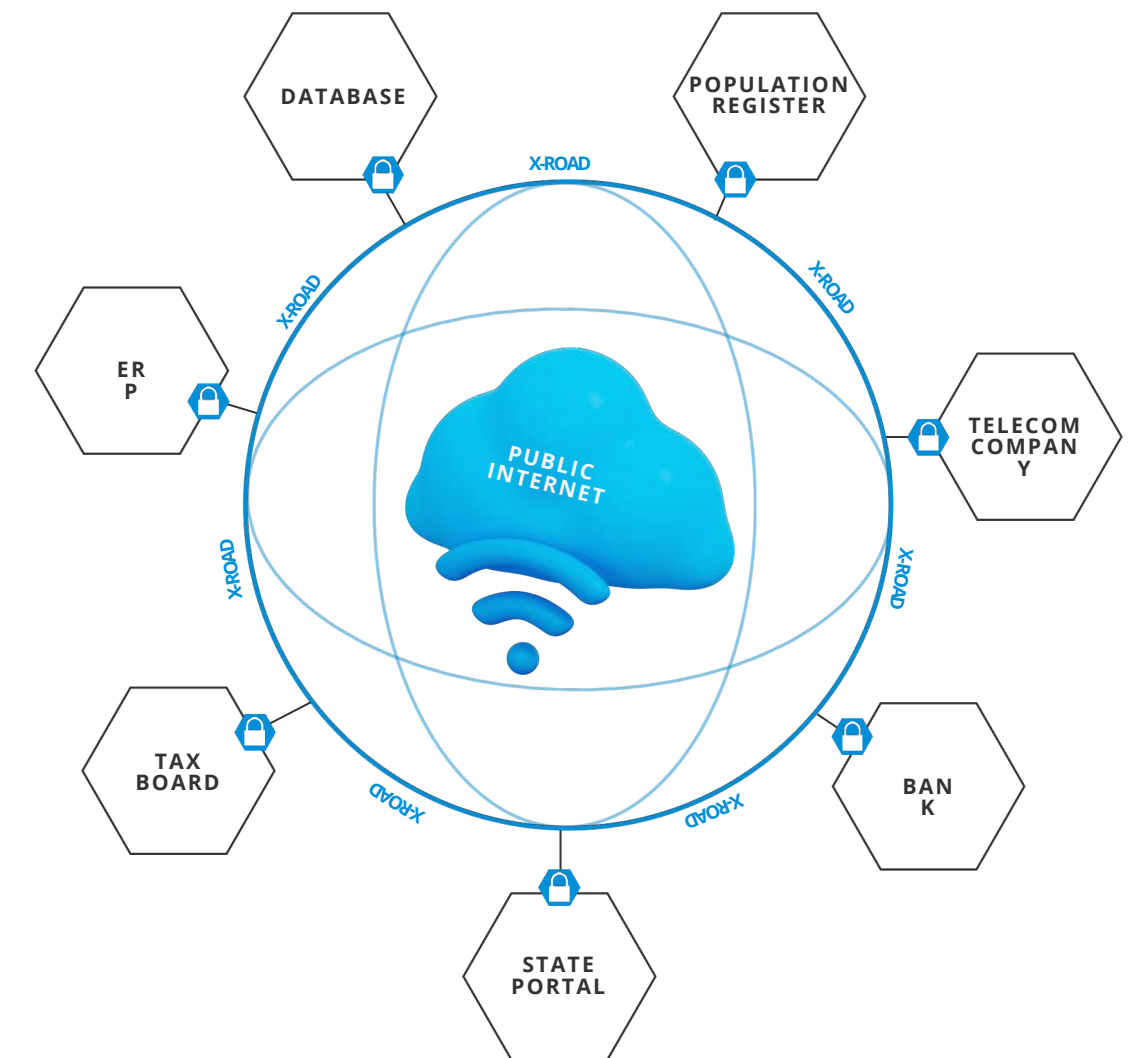

 - 134 countries represented in the x-road community



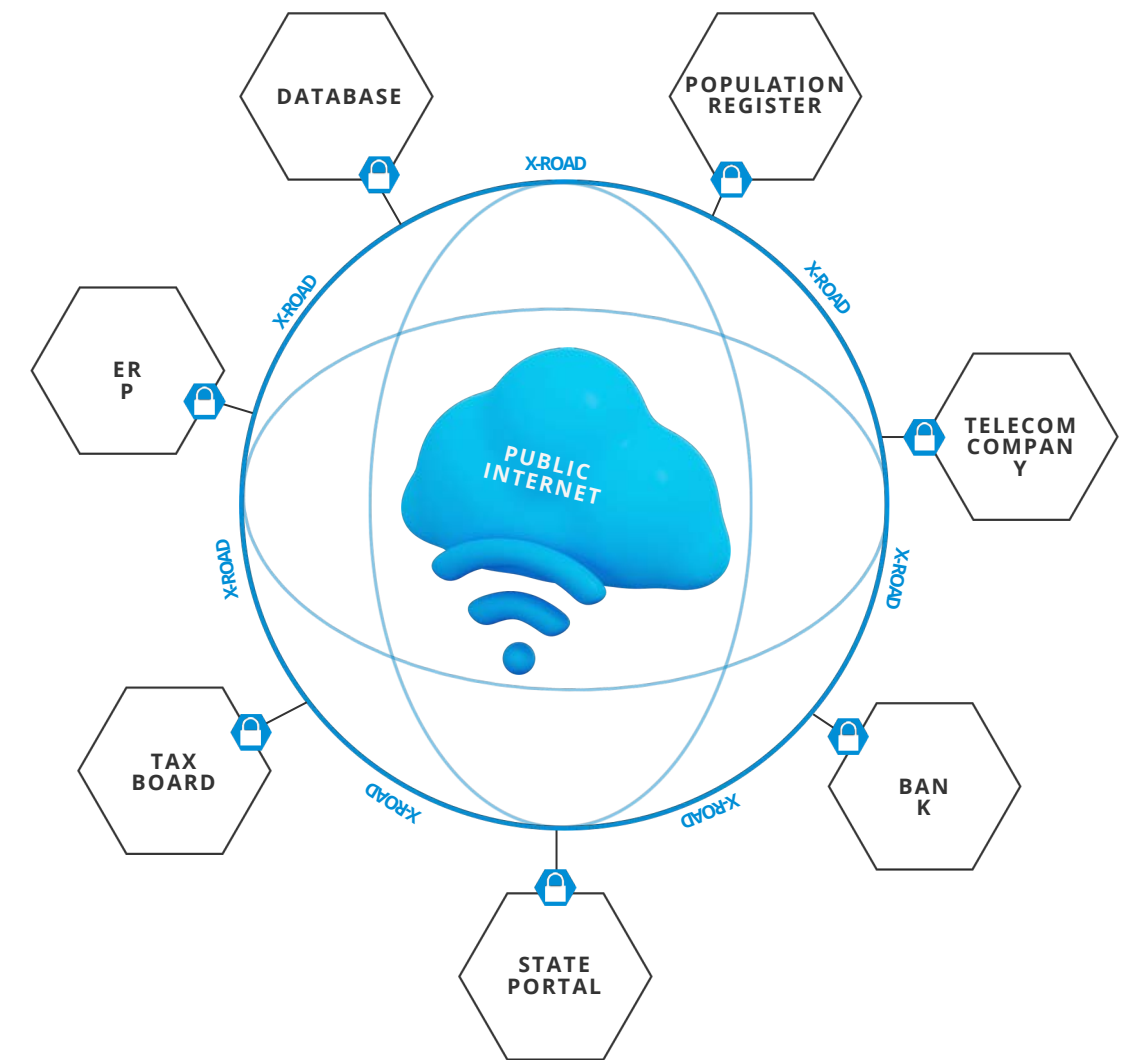

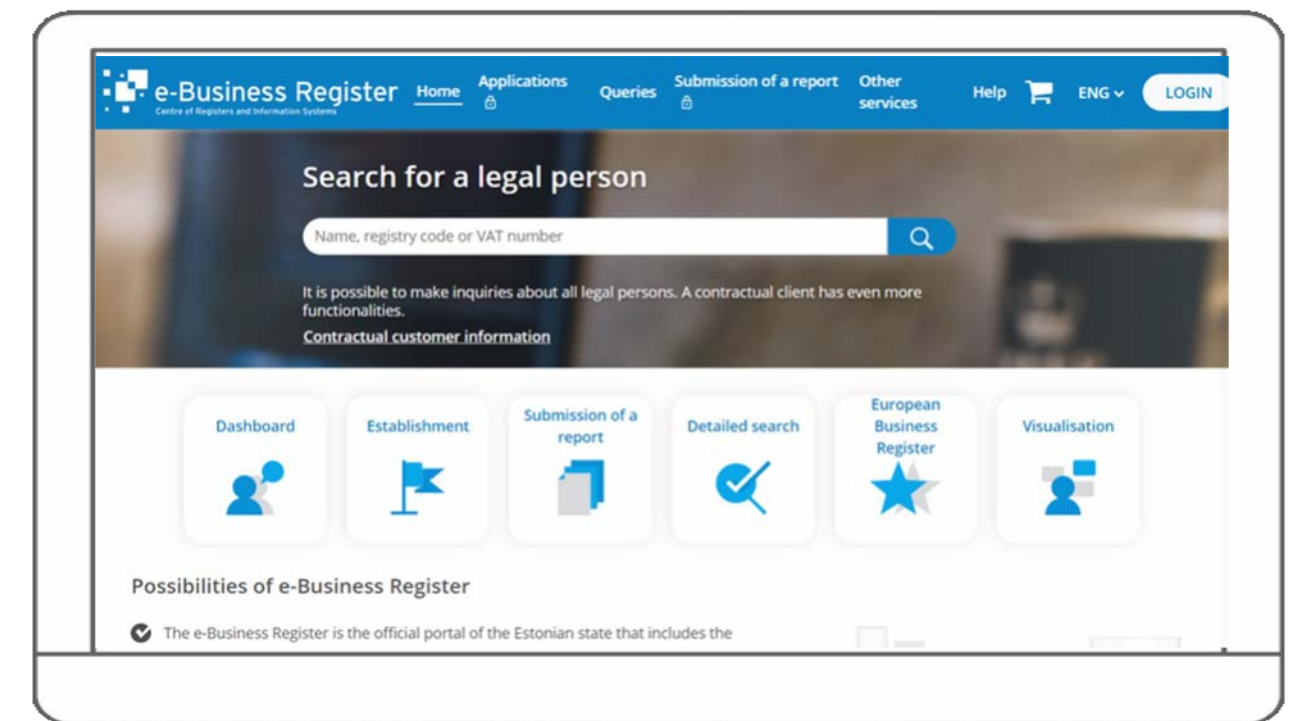

Green digital government:

The aim of the green IT initiative is to reduce the negative impact of technologies by designing, producing, using and later processing technologies in an environmentally friendly manner.

Business register of Estonia

- Under the Tartu County Court
- 349 000 legal entities
- Fully digital register: businessregister.ee
- All legal types in one system
- Open data (via portal, APIs, bulk download)



Business register of Estonia

- All applications and annual accounts received electronically (structured forms)
- Registrars are assistant judges working remotely
- No counter service
- No paper archives
- Avoiding legacy
- Using and developing re-usable components:
 - Document Delivery Portal
 - Autentication and signing
 - Virtual Assistant Bürokratt
 - Feedback



Mindset

- Looking for ways to achieve bigger wins with smaller effort
